Description and Current Status

The Board of Supervisors authorized County staff to work with HBA Architecture & Interior Design, Inc. on developing a Fire and EMS station that could be built all at once or in phases. The Director of Fire and EMS, Chief of Burrowsville Volunteer Fire Department and County staff have worked together or two options to be presented. An option for apparatus bay space only and a small office area and an option for a full fire and EMS station are being presented. Staff is seeking approval of one of the options and funding to move forward with the selected option.
