A RESOLUTION REQUESTING A MEMORIAL BRIDGE RESOLUTION FROM THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY HONORING LAWRENCE G. SPRADER, JR.

unanimously, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, Sergeant Lawrence G. "J.R." Sprader, Jr. was a native son of Virginia and graduated from Prince George High School on June 16, 2000; and

WHEREAS, just days after graduation, Sergeant Sprader enlisted in the United States Army on July 28, 2000; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Sprader served two full combat tours in Iraq in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom II; and

WHEREAS, in just under seven years of honorable and exemplary service in the United States Army, Sergeant Sprader amassed a superlative performance record; his personal awards and decorations included the Army Commendation Medal, Army Achievement Medal, Army Good Conduct Medal (2nd), National Defense Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Global War on Terror Expeditionary Medal, Army Service Ribbon, Combat Lifesaver Badge, First Class Driver's Badge, and Second Class Driver's Badge; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Sprader died during a field training exercise conducted by the 3rd Armored Cavalry Regiment, Warrior Leader Course, at Fort Hood, Texas, on June 12, 2007; and

WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors of Prince George County is profoundly grateful of his service and sacrifice and desires to honor Lawrence G. Sprader, Jr.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Prince George County Board of Supervisors request that the Virginia House of Delegates and the Virginia Senate pass a joint resolution designating the Middle Road Bridge over Interstate 295 as the Sergeant Lawrence G. Sprader Memorial Bridge. The Department of Transportation shall place and maintain appropriate markers indicating the designation of this bridge. This designation shall not affect any other designation heretofore or hereafter applied to this highway or any portion thereof. The Board of Supervisors agrees to pay costs assessed by the Virginia Department of Transportation for the erection of the appropriate markers.
