Re: Naming of Employee Breakroom

For well over 20 years, John Kines made significant contributions to Prince George County Government and its citizens as a Planner and later three different times as County Administrator. John's impacts on the lives of the employees were tremendous as he oversaw upgrades to salary schedules, benefits and training. His greatest strength was hiring the best group of loyal employees who were committed to advancing government at its highest level.

It is my recommendation the Employee Breakroom on the 2nd floor of the Administration Building be named in honor of Mr. Kines. The Breakroom is currently a popular location for employees to take breaks throughout the work day, and it is also a meeting area when necessary for civic and government use during and after regular office hours.

Currently, there is no name attached to the Breakroom. To have it permanently referred to as 'The John Kines Employee Breakroom' would give Mr. Kines much deserving recognition and continue to place his name in history as one of the key figures in Prince George County Government.

Mr. Kines has been approached about this possible recognition and humbly would accept if the idea met approval by the Board of Supervisors.

Action: Consensus to move forward with preparing a resolution to be placed on the April 10 BOS agenda officially naming the Breakroom after John Kines. It would be formally presented at a reception for National County Government Month at April 24 in which elected and appointed officials both past and present would be invited to attend.
