

## RESUME

### **Authority to Advertise Public Hearing for Virginia Department of Transportation Six-Year Plan for Prince George County Secondary Roads Improvement for Fiscal Years 2019 through 2024 and Secondary Roads Construction Budget for Fiscal Year 2018/19 for Prince George County**

Each year, the Code of Virginia requires the development of a local secondary six year road plan. The process requires notice in a newspaper and a public hearing as outlined in the Code of Virginia. Staff is requesting authority to advertise the public hearing for April 24, 2018 at 7:30pm.

#### Code of Virginia

§ 33.2-331. Annual meeting with county officers; six-year plan for secondary state highways; certain reimbursements required.

Following the preparation of the plan, the board of supervisors or other local governing body shall conduct a public hearing **after publishing notice in a newspaper published in or having general circulation in the county once a week for two successive weeks and posting notice of the proposed hearing at the front door of the courthouse of such county 10 days before the meeting.** At the public hearings, which shall be conducted jointly by the board of supervisors and the representative of the Department, the entire six-year plan shall be discussed with the citizens of the county and their views considered. Following the discussion, the local governing body, together with the representative of the Department, shall finalize and officially adopt the six-year plan, which shall then be considered the official plan of the county.

The Virginia Department of Transportation and the Board of Supervisors of Prince George County, in accordance with Section 33.2-331 of the Code of Virginia, will conduct a joint public hearing in the regular meeting room of the Prince George County Government Administration Building, 6602 Courts Drive, Prince George, Virginia at 7:30PM on Tuesday, April 24, 2018. The purpose of this public hearing is to receive public comment on the proposed Secondary Six-Year Plan for Fiscal Years 2018/2019 through 2023/2024 in Prince George County, and on the Secondary System Construction Budget for Fiscal Year 2018/19. Copies of the proposed Plan and Budget may be reviewed at the Petersburg Residency of the Virginia Department of Transportation, located at 4608 Boydton Plank Road, Petersburg, VA, 23803, or at the Prince George County Administrator's office located at 6602 Courts Drive, Prince George, VA, 23875.

All projects in the Secondary Six-Year Plan that are eligible for federal funds will be included in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP), which documents how Virginia will obligate federal transportation funds.
