Description and Current Status

On April 24, 2018 the Board of Supervisors authorized advertisement of a public hearing to amend the budget and appropriate unreserved General Fund Balance in the amount of \$1,960,636 to complete Fire Station 7 (Route 10 Fire Station). The public hearing advertisement ran in *The Progress Index* on April 28, 2018 (see attached – **Attachment A**). A public hearing is required because appropriation of these funds exceeds 1% of the adopted \$114,018,234 FY2018 budget or \$1,140,182.

To date, \$1,000,000 has been borrowed for the project, but the total projected budget is \$2,960,636, leaving a need for additional funding of \$1,960,636. In September 2017, the sitting board, by consensus, agreed to provide additional funding from unreserved Fund balance. A total project budget is shown as **Attachment B and totals** \$2,960,636.

Appropriation from balance will not create a violation of our policy percentage requirement.

The project will consist of the construction of a 10,459 square foot pre-engineered metal structure with a standing seam metal roof, concrete footings and slab turndowns.

IFB # 18-0319-1 was issued on March 19, 2018 by Finance for construction of Fire Station 7, with bid responses due by Monday April 9, 2018 at 2:00PM. One responsive bid was received from Kenbridge Construction and the board authorized award of contract to them on April 24, 2018.

Staff is requesting the board to authorize:

 Approval of a \$1,960,636 budget amendment and appropriation from Fund Balance following the public hearing.
