TOPIC:

Request for Approval and Appropriation of the Federal Department of Defense Educational Activity (DoDEA) Grant Funds for Use in FY19

RATIONALE:

Prince George County Public Schools currently has three five-year grants from DoDEA. These include:

- The Supporting Students in Reading (SSiR) grant which was originally in the amount of \$750,000.00. This grant is currently entering Year 4 of 5 and the amount of funds to be expended for FY19 is \$148,988.00. In addition to funds previously appropriated, the additional appropriation needed is \$32,014.00 for FY19.
- The Student Centered Learning to Support Success (S-CLaSS) 1.0 grant which was originally in the amount of \$1,250,000.00. This grant is currently entering Year 3 of 5 and the amount of funds to be expended for FY19 is \$169,824.23. The additional appropriation needed is \$8,390.23 for FY19.
- The Student Centered Learning to Support Success 2.0 (S-CLaSS 2.0) grant which was originally in the amount of \$750,000.00. This grant is currently in Year 2 of 5 and the amount of funds to be expended in FY19 is \$239,894.74. The additional appropriation needed is \$138,565.74 for FY19.
