**RESOLUTION; ADOPTION OF THE REVISED EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN FOR

This plan for Prince George County is designed to meet this responsibility and to include the County in the mutually supportive statewide emergency system. It also incorporates the National Incident Management System (NIMS) as the County standard for emergency response operations, as adopted by Prince George County resolution in 2005. The Prince George County EOP consists of a Basic Plan, Emergency Support Functions, Support Annexes, and Incident Annexes. Emergency Operations are to mirror day-to-day operations within government operations. A Continuity of Operations Plan (COOP) is in place to establish procedures for continuity for government operations.
