RESOLUTION; COMMENDATION; PRINCE GEORGE COUNTY GARAGE, PRINCE GEORGE FIRE AND EMS, PRINCE GEORGE EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS MANAGER; TOGETHER WE CAN EMPLOYEE RECOGNITION AWARD

WHEREAS, On September 8th, Fleet Manager Chris Talmage, Garage Mechanics Michael Tucker, Chris Jones and Timothy Horne and Fire Captain Chris Allin and Acting Fire Captain, Jason Coker suspected there could be an issue with fuel contamination; and

WHEREAS, Medic 192 and Medic 198 were brought into the garage having the same odd issues; and

WHEREAS, After taking a fuel sample, there was a high volume of gasoline in the fuel tank lines; and

WHEREAS, Shift Commander, Acting Captain Jason Coker and Fleet Manager, Chris Talmage reached out to Captain Chris Allin and Director of Fire & EMS, Brad Owens as well as General Services Director, Michael Purvis to make them aware of the potential problem; and

WHEREAS, Director Owens made the decision to take all Fire & EMS vehicles out of service and to establish mutual aid; and

WHEREAS, Staff worked quickly and efficiently to remove contaminate fuel from the units and worked with an outside vendor to drain the fuel tanks and replenish them with the proper fuel; and

WHEREAS, During the EOC activation, Fire & EMS and garage mechanics reported on the status of the fuel in each unit and coordinated all efforts with Captain Chris Allin and Acting Captain, Jason Coker while Emergency Communications Manager, Chad Bosserman worked to coordinate with the Communications Officers which units could be dispatched if a call were to come in; and

WHEREAS, On September 10th at approximately 11:00 a.m., all units were back in service and Fire & EMS was in service at full capacity.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED That the Board of Supervisors of the County of Prince George this 8th day of October, 2019, does hereby commend and thank the County Garage Staff, the Prince George Fire and EMS Department and the Emergency Communications Manager for their timely response and quick actions to resolve a potentially devastating situation; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED That this Board wishes to congratulate these dedicated employees for earning the Prince George County TOGETHER WE CAN Employee Award for meritorious service.
