Description and Current Status

We received insurance proceeds from VACORP for damages related to two police vehicles involved in a pursuit on February 2, 2020. A 2019 Ford Taurus Interceptor and a 2018 Ford Taurus Interceptor sustained damage (Police Department) when a pursuit ended in Hopewell. The suspect struck one police car and the other police car struck the suspect's vehicle to end the pursuit.
