# 2020 Market Plan

An online ordering guide is being developed by the Market Manager to allow customers to pre-order by Thursday of each week for Saturday curbside pick up.

The Market Manager will work with the IT Director to develop a form that is linked to the publication to allow customers to submit their order online and it will go to the Market Manager. The Market Manager will contact the vendors with the orders for Thursday evening.

Vendors will bring the orders to the designated pick up location on Saturday morning. The Market Manager will be there to process payments and pay the vendors.

# 2020 Market Plan

Starting the week of May 11th – Sunday through Thursday online pre-orders. Vendors will bring their products for curbside pick up on May 11<sup>th</sup> and pay using debit/credit/cash/EBT.

June 13<sup>th</sup> – Market opening at Scott Park pavilion adhering to social distancing and 10 customers at a time. Online pre-ordering with curbside pick up will still be available throughout the entire market season.

October 31<sup>st</sup> – Final day for the Market.

- With COVID-19, all extracurricular events will not be scheduled. This includes story time, food vendors and children's activities.

- Write an article for the newspaper to talk about the new online ordering & curbside pick-up.
- Open the Market on June 13<sup>th</sup> to 10 customers at a time.
- If Executive order 53 changes to allow the Market to open as normal, we will plan to do that. We will continue to allow pre-orders for the customers who prefer that method.
- Buy Fresh – Buy Local Paper will be updated.
- Flyers will be printed for posting in County Businesses.
- The Website and Facebook Page will both have links to the online ordering guide and pre-order forms.
