Description and Current Status

On June 9, 2020 the Prince George County Board of Supervisors conducted a public hearing to raise the transient occupancy tax rate from 5% to 7%, and approved the rate increase.

The Tourism Fund Lodging Tax Revenue will increase and not the General Fund, as the maximum that may be deposited into the General Fund is a 2% lodging tax. Tourism Fund revenues are expected to increase by a total of \$180,879, with some consideration of COVID-19 impacts.

The adopted FY2021 budget included the lodging tax rate at 5%, so a budget amendment is needed to reflect an increase in revenues and expenditures.

Board Action Requested: Approve budget amendment / increase in Tourism Fund revenues and expenditures. A Draft budget amendment / appropriation is attached for Board consideration.
