Description and Current Status

There is a desire to relocate the polling location in the Prince George County Courthouse to the Gregory Memorial Presbyterian Church in precinct number 204. Per Code of Virginia 24.2-306, such a move must be approved 60 days prior to the general election. Staff is requesting Authority to Advertise the public hearing on the ordinance change and to set a special meeting of the Prince George County Board of Supervisors on Tuesday, September 1, 2020 for the public hearing and ordinance consideration. The advertisement must be posted per state code and, if approved, voters would have to be notified by mail in advance of the election.
