Description and Current Status

Kevin Foster, Chief of the Prince George County Volunteer Fire Department, has requested the County transfer of title of a 1968 Ford 850 Pumper to them (VIN F86KUD56392). See attached email request (**Attachment A**).

The truck is no longer in service and was most recently used for the now eliminated Rowanty Firefighter / EMT course. The vehicle has been declared surplus, and the staff recommendation is to donate the vehicle to Company 1 as requested.

Donation of such property is allowed under the Code of Virginia §15.2-953(B).

Chairman Hunter and Mr. Ashcraft,

The membership of Prince George Volunteer Fire Department, Company 1, is seeking permission from the County to transfer the title of the 1968 Ford 850 Pumper (52 years old) to the department so that it can be sold. The unit is currently in non-ready reserve status and the upkeep of it over the last few years has been minimal. It was previously used by the Firefighting/EMT program at Rowanty and was housed at their facility. This program at Rowanty has been eliminated and the school needs to reclaim the space for new programming. In discussion with various parties of interest (i.e. Old Dominion Historical Society & private collectors), we feel this unit would sell for \$2,500 - \$5,000 and we would like to be able to use these funds for firefighting equipment or apparatus needs.

Secondly, the Department is exploring the idea of beginning a weekly bingo gaming operation. At this point, we are gathering costs of entry, charitable gaming regulations (including permitting and reporting), commitment from the membership, etc. We operated bingo from the late 1980's until 2003. During that time, we gave \$50,000 of the cost associated with Engine 120 (Now Engine 8), purchased Engine 12 (approximately \$125,000), Squad 1 (\$135,000), initial Truck 1 purchase (\$100,000), Jeep and Brush units, Responder 1 and Utility 1. Proceeds from bingo operations assisted with numerous pieces of firefighting equipment, station needs, uniforms and turnout gear and so much more.

We would like to know if the County would allow us to proceed with weekly bingo gaming again in our building.
