Our OE's Our Officers of Election worked through the November 3, 2020 Presidential Election even with the added risk of possible contact with any voters who may have put their health and possibly the health of their families at risk to serve during this time.

As a result of this risk and possible sacrifice, we request each Officer of Election working on Election Day, November 3, 2020, be paid an additional \$100 for the day, as hazard pay. This will be in addition to their normal rate of pay and will be a one time charge against the allowed CARES Funding. The total one time hit to the CARES Funding will be \$12,100.

This should help with any COVID testing and/or time out of work to serve the county.
