PROPOSAL:

To Accept the Virginia Tiered Systems of Supports Grant Funding

RATIONALE:

In the Spring of 2019, the elementary schools applied to become apart of the Virginia Tiered Systems of Supports Cohort for the 2020-2021 school year. The Virginia Tiered Systems of Supports (VTSS) is a data-informed decision-making framework for establishing the academic, behavioral and social-emotional supports needed for a school to be an effective learning environment for all students.

Prince George County Schools was accepted into the cohort in the summer. The division level team consisting of administrators and School Board Office representatives have attended several virtual professional development workshops. The school system has a coach from VTSS, Dr. Charlome Pierce. Dr. Pierce works closely with our district level team to guide us through the VTSS process.

Prince George County Schools has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$25,000 to help the division implement the VTSS program. The district level VTSS team will work with our coach, Dr. Pierce, to create a budget to submit to the VDOE for approval.

1 am pleased to inform you that on November 4, 2020, The Cameron Foundation approved a Reopening Schools emergency grant of \$50,000 to Prince George County Public Schools.

This grant is a Reopening Schools emergency grant in the amount of \$50,000 to Prince George County Public Schools to help pay for internet hotspot service. In making this grant the Foundation is not obligated to make a future grant for this or any other purpose.

This grant has been approved with the understanding, based upon your representations, that Prince George County Public Schools is exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) OR Section 170(c)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code. (Note: a 501 (c)(3) organization cannot now, nor have been within the last five years, classified as a "private foundation" as described in Section 509 (a) of said Code.) Further, in accepting this grant Prince George County Public Schools agrees that the grant funds will be used exclusively for exempt purposes as described in Section 501(c)(3) or Section 170(c)(1), as applicable, and will not be used for the carrying on of propaganda, nor for otherwise attempting to influence legislation (within the meaning of the taxable expenditure prohibition rules of Treasury Regulations §53.4945-2), nor for participating in, or intervening in, any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

The grant also is expressly conditioned upon the following:

- 1. The grant funds must be used exclusively for the purpose or purposes described in the proposal your organization submitted to the Foundation; provided, however, that if your organization determines that a material variance in use is required or desirable, your organization may request a variance in use from the Foundation. The Foundation will have no obligation to permit such a variance, and your organization must not implement any such variance unless and until it receives written permission from the Foundation.
- 2. Your organization must submit to the Foundation both a post-grant evaluation report

and a post-grant financial report with respect to the activities funded by the grant. These forms must be completed on the Foundation's website, (www.camfound.org) at the applicant login section. Reporting must be submitted on or before the following dates:

7/31/2021 Final Report

The Foundation also would welcome your submission of any other program or financial reports that your organization may prepare.

If your organization, without a reason acceptable to the Foundation, fails to submit the reports described above when they are due, the Foundation may require your organization to return all or a portion of the grant funds to the Foundation. In addition, unexcused delinquencies or tardiness in furnishing the reports may result in the denial of grant requests by your organization for a period of five years.

This grant will be made according to the following payment schedule:

If your organization is a publicly supported organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, be advised that the Foundation is a private foundation and only a portion of this grant may qualify as public support.

By acceptance and deposit of this check, your organization accepts the stated terms of this agreement.
