## ORDINANCE TO AMEND "THE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF PRINCE GEORGE, VIRGINIA", 2005, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING § 6-146 TO CLARIFY THE LANGUAGE FOR A DOG RUNNING AT LARGE AND TO PROVIDE FOR A CIVIL PENALTY OF UP TO \$100 FOR DOGS RUNNING IN A PACK WHICH IS DEFINED AS THE DOG RUNNING AT LARGE IN THE COMPANY OF ONE OR MORE DOGS THAT ARE ALSO RUNNING AT LARGE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Prince George County:

(1) That The Code of the County of Prince George, Virginia, 2005, as amended, is amended by amending § 6-146, as follows:

**CHAPTER 6 ANIMALS** 

ARTICLE II. Dogs and Cats Generally

DIVISION 4. Dogs Running at Large

Sec. 6-146. - Running at large prohibited in county.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for the owner of any dog to permit or allow such dog to run or be at large within the county. A dog shall be deemed to be at large when <u>roaming or running</u> off the property of its owner or custodian and not under the <u>direct immediate</u> control of the owner, custodian or his agent, either by leash, cord or chain. <u>A dog shall be deemed to be running at large in a pack if the dog is running at large in the company of one or more dogs that are also running at large.</u>
- (b) This section shall not apply to any person while engaged in a supervised formal obedience training class or show or during field trials training, hunting training, or while engaged in lawful hunting with a dog during open season. It shall be unlawful for the owner of a dog to place such dog in the custody of any other person not physically capable of maintaining effective control of such dog.
- (c) The owner or custodian of a dog found while running at large in a pack shall be subject to civil penalty in the amount of \$100.00 per dog so found.
