Description and Current Status

Prince George County requires additional construction inspection services for the Route 156 Water Main Extension project. A previous contract for inspection services was awarded to Dewberry Engineers Inc. for the initial Not-To-Exceed amount of \$150,000, which included services for the Route 460 Water Main Extension, the Route 156 Water Main Extension and the Food Lion Booster Station Upgrade projects. The Route 156 Water Main Extension was allocated \$50,000 of the previous award. These funds have been exhausted. Construction of the pipeline is scheduled to be completed in July 2022. Dewberry Engineers, Inc. has provided a proposal to cover the remaining inspection services for a Not-To-Exceed amount of \$120,000.

The inspection services will be completed utilizing the Annual Engineering Services Contract. Individual awards for specific projects in excess of \$50,000 require Board approval. Staff recommends an award of the contract for Route 156 Water Main Extensions Construction Inspection services to Dewberry Engineers, Inc.

Fiscal Impact Statement

\$2,640,000 for the Route 156 Water Line Extension was included as part of the General Obligation borrowings, Bond Series Spring 2019. An additional appropriation of funds of \$323,576.24 from Utility Cash Reserves / Fund Balance was made when the project was awarded. Total project encumbrances and expenditures to date are \$2,963,576.24. Award of this contract requires additional appropriation of funds totaling \$120,000, which is available in the Utility CIP fund.

WHEREAS, Award of this contract requires additional appropriation of funds totaling \$120,000, which is available in the Utility CIP Fund; and



Dewberry Engineers Inc. (Dewberry) is pleased to submit our proposal to provide professional engineering services for continued construction inspection services required for the Route 156 Water Main Extension project. Our Project Understanding, Scope of Services, and Fee have been developed based on correspondence with County staff. All work under this proposal will be performed in accordance with the terms and conditions of our Contract for On-Call Engineering Services with Prince George County, executed April 1, 2019.

PROJECT UNDERSTANDING

Dewberry understands that Prince George County (Owner) is seeking continued construction inspection services for Phase 2 of the construction of the Route 156 Water Main Extension project. Phase 2 consists of construction inspection services required beyond the initial construction inspection task limit of \$150.000.

Construction Notice to Proceed was issued November 30, 2020 for Route 156 Water Main Extension. It is anticipated that construction for Route 156 is estimated to continue for an additional eight to nine months.

The initial construction inspection task is nearing completion. As such, this proposal will cover inspection services through a Phase 2 Not-To-Exceed amount of \$120,000. As construction progresses and if there are any additional delays or continued construction inspection is required, the need to issue additional Not-To-Exceed amounts will be evaluated and discussed with the Owner.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Dewberry will perform the services outlined below.

1. Construction Inspection

- 1.1 For construction inspection services for the waterline, provide construction inspection to monitor the Contractor's work and verify compliance with the contract documents for the anticipated construction of the three projects listed. The Inspector for the project will have an hourly billing rate for Inspector I (\$80 per hour), Inspector II (\$100 per hour), or Inspector III (\$115 per hour).
- 1.2 This portion of the provided services will be billed using a Not-To-Exceed fee structure.

FEE

Dewberry's Not-To-Exceed Phase 2 amount for these services is \$120,000 for the construction inspection of the Route 156 Water Main Extension project. As construction progresses and if there are any additional delays or continued construction inspection is required, the need to issue additional Not-To-Exceed amounts will be evaluated and discussed with the Owner.

EXCLUSIONS

The following services are specifically excluded from the scope of services but could be provided by Dewberry as additional services if authorized in writing by the OWNER.

- Specific services outside of those identified in the Scope of Services outlined above will be deemed an additional service.
- Preparing to serve or serving as a consultant or witness for OWNER in any litigation, arbitration or other legal or administrative proceeding involving the Project.
- 3. Additional or extended services during construction resulting from significant delays, changes or price increases occurring as a direct or indirect result of the CONTRACTOR's material, equipment, labor or energy shortages, work damaged by fire or other causes during construction, a significant amount of defective or neglected work of any CONTRACTOR, acceleration of the schedule involving services beyond normal working hours, and default by any CONTRACTOR.
