ORDINANCE TO AMEND "THE CODE OF THE COUNTY OF PRINCE GEORGE, VIRGINIA", 2005, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING § 63-72(h) TO REQUIRE A ROAD NAME FOR PUBLIC AND PRIVATE RIGHT-OF-WAY OR ACCESS EASEMENTS ACCESSING THREE OR MORE PROPERTIES OR ADDRESSABLE STRUCTURES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Prince George County:

(1) That The Code of the County of Prince George, Virginia, 2005, as amended, is amended by amending § 63-72(h), as follows:

CHAPTER 63 ADDRESSING

ARTICLE III. NAMING OF STREETS

Sec. 63-72. – Approval of proposed names; general naming.

(h) Only pPublic and private rights-of-way or access easements accessing five three or more properties or addressable structures shall be named. Addressable structures served by rights-of-way or access easements serving less than three properties or addressable structures, or such single-owner private access easements that are not named, shall be addressed using the name of the travelway from which the right-of-way or single-owner private access easement originates.

Any single-owner private access easement previously named may have such name removed upon the request of the owner. Requests for naming, or removing names from, single-owner private access easements shall be submitted in writing to the office. Addresses for addressable structures on single-owner private access easements for which the owner requests either a name or the removal of a name will be assigned or reassigned in accordance with the provisions of this chapter.

(2) That the Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.
