#### **Description and Current Status**

The Drug Court Coordinator indicated that she estimates a small amount of additional funding is needed for the Drug Court Program for FY2022. An additional \$1,000 is needed for drug tests (for costly sweat patches), and approximately \$500 more is needed for client incentives (incentives provided to program participants for reaching sobriety milestones). A total of \$1,500 is being requested (recommended funding source General Fund Contingency).

The Drug Court Coordinator has also requested additional support from Riverside Criminal Justice Agency for increased hours for home visits for deputies, and related overtime pay of approximately \$6,800. That additional support is not included in this request, and the recommended funding source is RCJA Fund, Fund Balance (Fund 0217).

**Board Action Requested:** 

Approve budget transfer from General Fund Contingency to the Drug Court Program in the amount of \$1,500.00 for drug tests and incentives.
