Description and Current Status

We received insurance proceeds from VACORP for damages related to a 2019 Ford Explorer Interceptor (Police Department; VIN 5278). The vehicle was damaged on June 5, 2022 when a suspect's car struck the police vehicle while attempting to elude police. The vehicle sustained damage to its front. The estimated repairs for the vehicle were \$9,545.02, and the amount received is \$9,045.02 (repair estimate, less \$500 deductible).
