Description and Current Status

Prince George County received an Asset Forfeiture distribution totaling **\$19,810.49** on August 17, 2022. Asset Forfeiture distributions are reconciled quarterly, and if they are less than \$5,000, are appropriated by the County Administrator. Because this distribution exceeded \$5,000, Board approval of the appropriation is required.

The State and Federal asset Forfeiture programs were established to punish and deter criminal activity by depriving criminals of property used in or acquired through illegal activities. The State and Federal governments retain a portion of cash collected and sales proceeds and distribute the balance to localities. Localities may use these funds for any law enforcement activity.

Board Action Requested:

Approve appropriation of State Asset Forfeiture Proceeds - \$19,810.49; Police Department distribution \$13,343.85 and Commonwealth’s Attorney distribution \$6,466.64.
