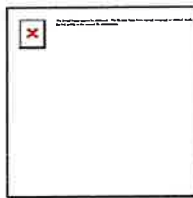

The total grant award amount above includes the following:

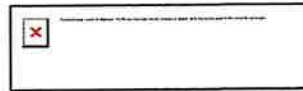
Non-Competitive Grant Award: \$14,501.00
