PUBLIC HEARING: PROPOSED EASEMENT FOR PRINCE GEORGE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE ON COUNTY PROPERTY AT TAX MAP ID# 450(0A)00-048-0 (CENTRAL WELLNESS CENTER)

Due to the Love's Travel Stops & Country Stores (Love's) development on Route 156 and Route 460, the Prince George Electric Cooperative (PGEC) must relocate electric lines on the proposed Love's property and on Prince George County property located at the Central Wellness Center.

The PGEC request is for a perpetual utility easement, approximately forty feet (40') in width and approximately two hundred feet (200') in length, over, under and across the following described property: A tract of land containing approximately fourteen (14) acres, located in the Blackwater Magisterial District, Prince George County, Virginia, Tax Map ID# 450(0A)00-048-0.

The attached map shows where electric lines will be removed and where new electric lines will be installed. There is no cost to the County for this easement.

A legal advertisement for the public hearing was published in the Progress-Index on March 2, 2017. Public notice is required to be advertised at least seven (7) days before the public hearing held March 14, 2017.

A copy of the legal advertisement and draft easement contract between the County and PGEC are attached.



RESOLUTION; AUTHORITY TO AUTHORIZE EXECUTION OF EASEMENT FOR PRINCE GEORGE ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE AT CENTRAL WELLNESS CENTER AT TAX MAP ID# 450(0A)00-048-0
WHEREAS, Prince George Electric Cooperative is requesting a perpetual 200 ft. +/-, non-exclusive permanent utility easement with a width of 20 feet across County property at the Central Wellness Center at tax map # 450(0A)00-048-0. The proposed easement runs along the southern edge of the subject property line adjacent to the main entrance road; and
WHEREAS, a public hearing regarding the proposed easement has been duly advertised and conducted by the Prince George Board of Supervisors.

WITNESSETH:

That for a good and valuable consideration, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Owner does grant and convey to and unto the Cooperative, a perpetual utility easement, approximately forty feet (40') in width and approximately two hundred feet (200') in length, immediately adjacent to Prince George Drive, over, under and across the southern edge of following described property:

A tract of land containing approximately fourteen (14) acres, located in the Blackwater Magisterial District, Prince George County, Virginia, Tax Map ID# 450(0A)00-048-0, as delineated on the attached plat, which plat is incorporated by reference;

for the purpose of constructing an electric transmission or distribution system, either overhead or underground, and to operate and maintain the electric system, including all necessary lines, wires, poles, cables, conduits, manholes, equipment, accessories and appurtenances.

The facilities installed shall remain the property of the Cooperative and the Cooperative shall have the right to inspect, rebuild, remove, relocate, improve, and to make such changes, alterations, substitutions or additions to its facilities as it may deem advisable, including the right to increase the number of wires, cables or lines.

The Cooperative shall at all times have the right to keep the easement clear of all buildings, structures and other obstructions, to spray with chemicals, trim, cut and keep clear all trees, limbs, and undergrowth along or adjacent to the easement that may endanger the safe and proper operation of the Cooperative's facilities.

Any shrubbery, fence or other structure placed on the easement shall be done so at the risk of the property owner and the Cooperative shall not be held responsible for damage done to any structure, shrubbery or fence resulting from the Cooperative maintaining, inspecting and operating its facilities.

In addition to the easement, the Owner does hereby grant unto the Cooperative, during the period of construction and during any subsequent period in which maintenance, inspection, repairs or reconstruction thereof may be necessary, the right and privilege of using such surrounding land as may be necessary for the purpose of placing materials, machinery and equipment as may be necessary.
