Re: Contribution to Prince George Regional Heritage Center – 7.5% of Transient

Occupancy Tax Dedicated to Tourism Fund

The Prince George County Board of Supervisors adopted a resolution (R-07-134) on December 27, 2007 resolving to provide 5% of the Transient Occupancy Taxes Dedicated for Contribution to Tourism to the Prince George Historical Society effective July 1, 2008.

During a FY2016 budget work session, the board, by consensus, agreed to increase the contribution to the Prince George Regional Heritage Center (formerly known as the Prince George Historical Society) from 5% to 7.5%. The board did not take formal action to increase this contribution percentage by resolution.

At the April 5, 2017 budget work session, staff received direction to bring the board a resolution to formally increase the contribution to 7.5%. The resolution is attached for board consideration. A copy of the December 2007 resolution is also provided for reference.
